Household size and contributions to income includes anyone living in your household who is related by blood (relatives) or by marriage.

To calculate the current income level, you will need to look at your pay stubs for the last 6 months. Add up the amounts for the entire 6-month period for you and anyone else in your household. Once you have this amount added up, double it (multiply it by two.) This is your annual household income. Compare this number to the above chart.
